Submission deadline is February 15, 2017

ISEB invites proposals for our annual conference! We welcome papers from any discipline or context that engage in aspects of biography focused on the broad theme of “lives that are educative and educator’s lives.” We also encourage submissions from graduate students.

Possible Topics

Collective biographies, the role of biography in the history of education, family biographies, publishing biographies, critical or feminist approaches to life writing, oral history, experimental approaches, ethical issues, auto/biographical research, narrative research, methodology, and using biography in classrooms.

Proposal Information:

The refereed conference invites individual papers, panel discussions, as well as alternative formats. Generally, the conference schedule allows 30 minutes for individual papers (includes discussion time), and 60-75 minutes for panel discussions and other kinds of presentations. Include the following information in your proposal:

1. A title page which includes title, name of author(s), address, telephone #, and e-mail.
2. A 250-350 word abstract describing the importance of the topic to biographical work, the research or pedagogical approach taken & the need for technology.
3. Please state any time and day that you cannot present.
